will receive

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students at or above the NAPLAN National Minimum Standard to 90% in Year 3 and Year 5 in all areas excluding students on Individual Curriculum Plans (ICP)
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' standard or above in Mathematics from 75% in 2015 to greater than 80% in 2016
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' standard or above in English from 65% in all year levels in 2015 to greater than 80% in 2016
- Every student accessing a different year level curriculum (that is, with an ICP) will achieve a 'C' standard or better against the relevant year level achievement standard
- Increase the percentage of students in the NAPLAN upper two bands (U2B) to 40% in Years 3 and 5 in Reading

Our initiatives include

- All staff will receive professional development in the Reading to Learn Program. This program will be implemented across all year levels and become the corner stone for how reading is taught at Bororen State School
- Teachers and Teacher Aides will work with students individually and in small groups to achieve set learning goals
- Regular collection and analysis of data to develop individual student learning targets and goals
- Professional Development for all staff in Visible Learning (Professor John Hattie) to ensure that teachers are providing students with the best possible learning opportunity
- Provide professional development and coaching to ensure teachers are able to deconstruct Australian Curriculum in the subject areas of English, Mathematics and Science
- Prepare and support teacher aides to consolidate student learning in numeracy and literacy (including oral language and metalinguistic)

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Initiating the Reading to Learn Program and professional development for staff members \$7000.00
- Employ an extra teacher for one day per week for ten weeks for intensive learning support. \$4500.00
- Employ additional teacher aides to support the students in reading and numeracy development across all year levels \$10,000.00
